

E-ZEE Stick On (Self Adhesive Backing)

E-ZEE®

Cut a piece of E-ZEE Stick On larger than the frame. Place the entire piece, including the protective paper, into the frame, with the protective paper on top, as in figure one.

Before placing the frame on the machine, cut out a small piece of backing from the centre where the stitch plate would be. This should be at least as big as the embroidery design (see figure 2).

Using a fine blade, cut a 2 cm wide border from the protective paper only around the resulting hole, and then pull this off, as in figure 3.

Stable base material:

When embroidering stable base material, a piece of different non-woven backing, for example Ultra Soft, larger than the embroidery design, should be placed over the hole and the sticky border. The garment is then placed on top and embroidered.

Open Weave/knitwear/stretch fabric:

- a) Iron on a piece of Cotton Soft Iron On backing, larger than the embroidery design, onto the reverse of the fabric and then fix this onto the glue side of the E-ZEE Stick On border in the frame, or
- b) Place a piece of E-ZEE Stick On onto the open weave fabric, then stick onto the glue side of the E-ZEE Stick On border in the frame (see figures 4 and 5).
